In case they fail to attend the Railway Recruitment Cell, Central Railway on the scheduled date or unable to produce the required documents, their candidature will be cancelled.

Candidates are required to submit legal document, in original, with respect to any variation in candidate's name, father's name etc in any of the document submitted, without which they will not be sent for medical examination. Candidates found eligible will be directed for medical examination at Byculla / Kalyan / Bhusawal / Nagpur / Pune / Solapur for which they may have to stay for 3-4 days.

Candidates are advised to come prepared accordingly.

Important Instructions :

- I. Candidate have to meet the Quarantine requirement of Maharashtra state before his/her date of reporting for document verification.
- II. The guidelines issued by Maharashtra state regarding CORONA-19, time to time, for SOPs of Maharashtra state have also to be followed by the candidate by checking Maharashtra state's official website.
- III. Candidate will be asked to carry/produce a COVID-19 negative certificate at the time of document Verification not more than 2 days old before leaving home. Without such certificate, candidate will not be entertained for document verification as candidates will travel from containment zones.
- IV. Central Railway will not be responsible to take care of the candidates fall sick at RRC/CR. In such cases, candidates have to make their own arrangements.
- V. Candidate must maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet at RRC/CR.
- VI. Use of face covers/masks is mandatory.
- VII. Practice frequent hand washing with soap even when hands are not visibly dirty.
- VIII. Frequent use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers.
- IX. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- X. Self-monitoring of health by the candidate and reporting any illness at the earliest to state and district helpline.
- XI. Spitting will be strictly prohibited.
