Candidates are also advised to follow the following instructions :

- Candidates have to meet the Quarantine requirement of Maharashtra state before Candidates due date of reporting for document verification. Candidates have to make their own arrangements. The guidelines for SOPs of Maharashtra state have also to be followed by the candidates.
- Candidates will be asked to carry/produce a COVID-19 negative certificate at the time of document verification not more than 03 days (72 hours) old before leaving home as per Maharashtra state guidelines issued vide dated 15.07.2021. Without such certificate, candidates will not be entertained for document verification as they will travel from containment zones. However, this will not be applicable to the candidates who have taken both vaccination and 15 days have been lapsed since the administration of second dose of the vaccine and is in possession of the final vaccination certificate issued through COWIN portal.
- Central Railway will not be responsible to take care of the candidate fall sick at RRC/CR. In such cases, candidates have to make their own arrangements.
- > Use of face covers/masks is mandatory.
- > Candidate must maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet at RRC/CR.
- > Practice frequent hand washing with soap even when hands are not visibly dirty.
- > Frequent use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers.
- Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest to state and district helpline.
- > Spitting will be strictly prohibited.
